The final determination of the category of an artwork and what constitutes "digital artwork" is at the discretion of the judges.

### Specs

1. Original work not previously exhibited in the Plymouth Guild Juried Art Show may be entered.
2. Work copied or done under the guidance of an instructor is not eligible.
3. Work may not exceed 48" in any direction.
4. Work must be framed, fully dry, signed, properly wired (no alligator clips) and ready for hanging.
5. Matting and framing should be of superior quality and complement the artwork. Worn, damaged or unprofessional frames should not be used.
6. Wires must be taut; strong enough to hold the piece; securely attached to the frame; and installed 1/3 of the distance from the top of the piece.
7. All drawings, original prints, watercolors and photos must be under glass or Plexiglas. Clamped glass, scarred mats, cracked glass, and damaged frames are not acceptable.
8. Sculptors and 3D artists may provide their own pedestals. A limited number of pedestals are available.
9. Work not ready for hanging or display will not be judged.

### Returns

Pick up work **not selected** for the show on Mon. Aug. 31<sup>st</sup> 3-7:30 pm.

Pick up **selected** artwork Sun. Sept. 27 4-6 pm or Tues., Sept. 29<sup>th</sup> from 4-7 pm.

### Liability

The Plymouth Guild, Inc. will not be responsible for fire, theft, loss or damage of any nature. Work is submitted at the artist's risk; the exhibition is not covered by insurance.

### Sales

The Plymouth Guild encourages artists to submit works for sale. Works must be priced or marked "Not for Sale." The value of work marked "Not for Sale" must be given; all prices to include frames. A 30% commission will be taken on all Guild Member sales, 40% for non-members.
